CANADIAN PAY-TV ORIGINAL SERIES *TERMINAL CITY* GARNERS RECOGNITION ALONGSIDE ITS INTERNATIONAL PEERS

Original Pay-TV Series is the only Canadian Miniseries Honoured by Banff World Television Awards

(April 10, 2006 - Toronto, Canada) The critically-acclaimed Canadian original pay-TV series *Terminal City* has been honoured as a **Hors Concours selection**, becoming the only Canadian miniseries to receive recognition by the 27th Annual Banff World Television Awards. Co-produced by Crescent Entertainment and Big Dog Productions in association with Corus Entertainment's **Movie Central** and Astral Media's **The Movie Network**, *Terminal City* is one of six miniseries from around the world to receive this honour. In addition, *Movie Central* and The Movie Network's pay-TV original series, *ReGenesis*, has garnered Canada's only nomination for a continuing series in this international competition.

"The Banff jury's recognition of these two particular series confirms that Pay-TV has an important role to play in supporting outstanding drama production in this country," says Shelley Gillen, Head of Creative and Business Affairs, Movie Central. "Ranked shoulder to shoulder, beside the best in the world, *Terminal City* and *ReGenesis* both stand out, illustrating what Canadians are capable of, working in partnership with broadcasters committed to creative excellence and vision."

"Our pay-TV originals strategy is founded on producing quality, entertaining dramatic series that play well both in Canada and internationally and the Banff World Television Awards' selection of these series is a testament to the standard of programming we are delivering," says Erica Benson, Director of Canadian Independent Productions, The Movie Network. "We are very proud of these series and congratulate each of the respective producers on their achievements."

Launched on Movie Central and The Movie Network in fall 2005, *Terminal City* is a darkly comedic exploration of a family living on the edge and in the shadow of cancer. The miniseries won unanimous praise from critics citing the production as a major step forward for Canadian television drama. *TV Times*, a nationally syndicated TV book, described the series as "one of the most original, intricate explorations of family dynamics ever created for television in Canada". And the syndicated wire service, Canadian Press commented: "Canadians, it seems, can create a show of HBO calibre with world class writing, acting and production values." *Terminal City* can be seen in Canada on Movie Central and The Movie Network.

ReGenesis is an internationally-renowned Canadian original drama series that explores the threat of science on society. Produced by Shaftesbury Films, the series' second season currently airs Sundays on Movie Central at 7 p.m. PT and on The Movie Network at 8 p.m. ET.

Banff World Television Awards nominees and Hors Concours selections are chosen via an independent judging process by the Festival's selection jury. In addition to nominations, programs are also selected as Hors Concours (out of competition) presentations, an honorific designation for programs that, while not selected as nominees, were deemed worthy of particular attention and recognition.
